

Progress Report on the St. Mary's Repair

Progress continues to be made toward the repair of the St. Mary's school. The members of the planning team have been busy organizing this major construction project. Team members include:

The team is targeting the following dates over the remainder of the year. This timeline leads to the start of construction to repair the St. Mary's building.

- November 16th
 - Completed design and development phase. All plan documents completed.
- December 7th
 - Receive and review all cost estimates provided by contractors and planners.
- December 15th
 - Completion of all plans and specs including changes from the city.
 - Secure building permit.
 - Send out bid specifications to contractors
- December 16th
 - Start necessary asbestos abatement
 - Begin preparation for demo work
- January 9th
 - Award bid for repair
 - Develop construction schedule
 - Complete asbestos abatement
 - Begin regular demo prior to construction

Once a contractor has been awarded the bid we will provide another update that will:

- Outline noteworthy dates in the construction schedule.
- Communicate schedule and goals specific to fundraising efforts.
