A message from the desk of Father Marreddy

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, December 29th, 2024-C Cycle Readings: Sirach 3, 2-6, 12-14; Col 3, 12-21; Luke 2:41-52

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family, remembering how Jesus grew up in the normal busy-ness of family life, how he was shaped as a person by both Mary and Joseph.

Today's feast is a celebration of **family**: that unique nucleus of society that gives us life, nurture, and support throughout our journey on earth. Families are the first and best places for the love of God to come alive.

Pope Francis wrote in his exhortation on family that the family is "where we learn to live with others despite our differences and to belong to one another." That very belonging to each is what today's readings are about.

In the first reading, Sirach entreats parents and children to love and honor each other. When one generation can no longer care for the other, he calls us to "take care of your father when he is old, even if his mind fails, be considerate of him." He adds the care we give for the elderly "will not be forgotten, firmly planted against the debt" of our own failings.

Our lives are so complicated, and families don't always consist of two parents. But Paul's letter to the Colossians offers all of us the tools we need to care for each other: heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another. When we share a home, we not only have to forgive each other, but to be aware that we need forgiveness from each other, prompted by the example of God's deeply loving forgiveness for us all.

Loving Jesus, as we celebrate this Christmas season, please help me to recognize your presence in the simplest times. Whether I am alone or with my family, even in the most mundane situations, you are calling me to a deeper relationship with you and reminding me of your endless love for me in those moments.

I am planning to visit my home country India, to spend time with my Parents, family, and friends. I will leave on January 14th, 2025, and will be back on Feb 20, 2025. Kindly keep my family and me in your kind prayers. You will be in my thoughts and prayers always.




