

#### A message from the desk of Father Marreddy

29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time (B) World Mission Sunday Isaiah 53:10-11 Hebrews: 4:14-16 Mark; 10:35-45


We tend to envy those who have made it to the top for their power and prestige. On the surface we see privilege and status, but much deeper are the obligations that come with leadership. Today's readings regard the top as the position of greatest service. The servant in the first reading represents those who are willing to share in a new and daring enterprise. By accepting this call the servant opens himself to suffering on behalf of the people. The leader's suffering will restore all to life with God. In today's gospel passage, James and John seek positions of honor when the Lord comes into his glory. Jesus explains that real honor is bound up with suffering. The "cup" is nothing less than the passion. Some people exercise their status in a show of power. By contrast, those who aspire to greatness in the Lord's kingdom must be servants. Genuine honor is found only in generous service.

#### WORLD MISSION SUNDAY TODAY

We are called to this Eucharistic celebration—along with Catholics in every parish, chapel, and church throughout the World to fulfill the call we first heard at Baptism, the call to be missionaries, to share our faith. On World Mission Sunday, we are called in a special way to be "missionaries of faith" through prayer and participation in the Eucharist, and by giving generously to the collection. Let us pray especially at this Mass for all who long to hear the hope-filled, saving message of Jesus, and for the priests, religious and lay catechists in mission countries worldwide who offer them that "Good News."


The coats are to be given to
