**Happy Father's Day** to all fathers! I pray that the Lord will send a special blessing upon all fathers, both living and deceased. May the unconditional love of God the Father shine forth in the lives of our fathers.

On Tuesday, June 18, I will be attending **Ministry Days** on the campus of St. Mary's University in Winona. I will be joining the priests, deacons, consecrated religious, and lay faithful from across the Diocese. This year's theme is *You are the Salt of the Earth: Baptized for Mission*, presented by **Deacon Keith Strohm**. Deacon Strohm is the Executive Director of M3 Ministries, and a long-time teacher and collaborator with the Catherine of Siena Institute. He has extensive experience in creating and sustaining programs of evangelization that focus on the making, maturation, and mission of disciples of Jesus Christ.

The Committee for Religious Liberty of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has designated June 22-29 as **Religious Freedom Week**. Beginning on June 22, the Memorial of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher, and concluding on June 29, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, *Religious Freedom Week* provides us with an opportunity to promote and defend our religious liberty in the United States of America. Our Lord says that some demons can only be driven out by "prayer and fasting." (Matthew 17:21) *Religious Freedom Week* is a beautiful time to combine prayer with fasting for the protection of our religious freedom. St. Anselm (+1109) wrote, "In this world, God loves nothing more than the liberty of His Church." (Magnificat. April 2015)

If you haven't already done so, please register your children and grandchildren for **Totus Tuus**. Totus Tuus (Latin for "Totally Yours") is the name of our Catholic Summer Faith Formation Program designed to help our young people to know, love, and serve God, and hopefully inspire them to give themselves "totally" to Christ. The teachers for Totus Tuus are a team are four college-aged men and women who go from parish to parish in the diocese all summer, providing school-age children with this outstanding one-week summer program. The Totus Tuus team will be at our parishes next week, June 23-28. Please see the bulletin for the complete registration information.

Effective June 9, 2024, Bishop Barron has appointed **Father Joshua Miller** as the Parochial Vicar of Sacred Heart Parish here in Owatonna. The Parochial Vicar, together with and under the authority of his pastor, is given the care of the souls of all who reside within the parish boundaries (cf. *Code of Canon Law*, can. 545 §1 and 548 §3). Father Miller's assignment letter states that he "will also assist with Sacramental ministry at St. Joseph Parish in Owatonna and Christ the King Parish in Medford." It is a special blessing for us to have one of the newly ordained priests serving our parishes, bringing – *in persona Christi capitis* ("in the person of Christ the head") – "the Lord to the faithful, and the faithful to the Lord." Please pray that Father Miller will be a holy priest, a "faithful servant of Christ, and a steward of the Mysteries of God." (1 Corinthians 4:1)

In addition to my assignment as Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish, Bishop Barron has appointed me as the **Dean of the Austin/Albert Lea Deanery**, effective July 1, 2024. The Diocese of Winona-Rochester is divided into five regions called "deaneries." The Dean is the liaison between the Bishop and the priests, deacons, and lay faithful of that particular deanery. Some of my new responsibilities include: (1) organizing a monthly meeting with the priests of the deanery; (2) caring for the priests and deacons of the deanery, especially those who are ill, or "who find themselves in more difficult circumstances, or are beset by problems"; (3) making an annual visit to each priest of the deanery to ensure that the priests diligently carry out their ministry, including accurately preserving the sacramental registers and administrating the ecclesiastical goods of the parish; (4) attending quarterly meetings with the other four deans, the Vicar General, and the Bishop; (5) serving as a member of the Clergy Personnel Committee, which assists the Bishop in making clergy assignments (cf. *Code of Canon Law*, can. 555).

Sacred Heart Cemetery is open year-round for your convenience. We ask you to please observe the following regulations:

- All flowers (real or artificial) must be kept in pots, placed in urn stands at least 15 inches above the ground, and placed to the side of the monument.
- <u>ALL items placed on the ground for Memorial</u>

  <u>Day will be removed after June 8</u> for the ease and safety of the maintenance workers.
- The following items are NOT permitted at any time: shepherd hooks; hoops; lawn flag holders; solar lights; and vigil lights (solar or battery powered). These items will be removed for the ease and safety of the maintenance workers.
- In-ground plantings are NOT permitted.
- Glass or wire are NOT permitted.
- Rocks in pots are NOT permitted.
- Pets are NOT allowed on cemetery property.
- The Cemetery Board reserves the right to remove items that are faded, out of season, or hazardous to visitors or maintenance workers.


