

# A message from the desk of Father Marreddy

# 26<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, September 29, 2024 – B Cycle

### Readings: Numbers 11:25-29; James 5:1-6; Mark 9:38-43, 45, 47-48

We live in a challenging world and are called to be prophets of God. We are invited to announce the Good News of God's deep love for each one of us. It is indeed important that we manifest this call in our behavior and daily activities and more importantly through our words. A prophet is one who stands for the values of God against the values of the world.

Do we rejoice in the good that others do? Jesus reprimands His disciples for their jealousy and suspicion. They were upset that someone who was not of their company was performing a good work in the name of Jesus. They even "forbade" the man "because he was not following us". Jesus' reply is filled with wisdom: "No one who does a mighty work in my name will be able soon after to speak evil of me." Are we not like the disciples when we get upset at the good deeds of others who seem to shine more than us? Paul says that "love is not jealous... but rejoices in the right" (1 Corinthians 13:4, 6).

Envy and jealousy are sinful because they lead us to sorrow over what should make us rejoice. The reason we may grieve over another's good is that somehow, we see that good as lessening our own value or excellence. Envy forms when we believe that the other person's advantage or possession diminishes or brings disgrace on us. Envy is contrary to love.

How can we overcome envy? With the love that God has put into our hearts through the gift of the Holy Spirit (Romans 5:5). The Holy Spirit purifies our hearts and frees us from our disordered passions, such as: envy, jealously, greed, and bitterness. God's love is a generous and selfless love which is wholly oriented towards our good. The love that God places in our hearts seeks the highest good of our neighbor and it compels us to give generously, especially to those who lack what they need.

I am going on a pilgrimage to Lourdes and Fatima from Sept 30<sup>th</sup> to Oct 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Please keep all pilgrims and me in your prayers. I will offer all the families of St. Joseph's and Christ the King to Mother Mary and intercede her motherly protection and blessings for all of us. Thanks Blessings!

We have been praying for our Owatonna priests since Fr. McGrath gave his approval in 2014. The "sisters" refers to women who commit to praying one holy hour per week on a specific day for a specific priest. While men can be substitutes, the "sisters" are women who commit to praying weekly. You pick the time. You pick the day. No meetings to attend. No dues! Just an

hour each week with you & Jesus!!

you, go without his reward." On September 27, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Vincent de Paul. The members of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul are on the front line in laboring for the poor, they are among the first to know their real needs.

During the months of June, July and August, through your gifts, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul was able to assist 145 Adults and 110 Children, providing \$991 in food, \$6424 for utilities, \$5064 towards rent, \$782 in car repairs, \$1280 for gas and \$600 for furniture. God Bless You!

Between both parishes last year we collected 160 winter coats. This year, we are collecting coats for all ages!




Your spare change can change a life! 2024 Baby Bottle Campaign Sponsored by the DOW-R and Catholic Charities' Child and Family Services

A rosary is a powerful intercessory prayer and our priests need our prayers more than ever.


### **A Rosary for Priests**

Diocese of Winona-Rochester -Child Sexual Abuse Policy Information

The Diocese of Winona-Rochester will provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employees, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should call the Victim Assistance Coordinator at 507-454-2270, Extension 255. A caller will be asked to provide his or her name and telephone number. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. The Diocese of Winona-Rochester is committed to protecting children, young people and other vulnerable people in our schools, parishes and ministries. The diocesan policy is available on the diocesan web site at <u>www.dowr.org</u> under the Safe Environment Program. If you have any questions about the Diocese of Winona's implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, please contact Michael Gerard, at 507-361-3377, or mgerard@dowr.org.

Anyone working or volunteering in a Catholic parish or school is a mandated reporter. Anyone who knows or has reason to believe that a minor (a person under the age of 18) or vulnerable adult is or has been abused or neglected, must report all suspected abuse or neglect to proper civil authorities/law enforcement within 24 hours of the abuse or neglect becoming known to him or her and must also follow up with a written report to civil authorities within 72 hours, exclusive of weekends and holidays. Many people working or volunteering in a Catholic parish or school, including clergy, are mandated reporters under state law.
