Tuesday of the Second Week of Lent

“If you are willing, and obey, you shall eat the good things of the land; but if you refuse and resist, the sword shall consume you: for the mouth of the Lord has spoken.”

Isaiah calls us to repentance because the Lord will then “set things right”.

“Why do you recite my statutes, and profess my covenant with your mouth, though you hate discipline and cast my words behind you?” The Lord’s words from Psalm 50.

Jesus tells us to “do and observe all things whatsoever” the scribes and Pharisees “tell you, but do not follow their example. For they preach but do not practice.”

Jesus concludes: “The greatest among you must be your servant. Whoever exalts himself will be humbled; but whoever humbles himself will be exalted.” Jesus fulfilled these very words, becoming our servant on the Cross, and He is the Greatest! His Holy Humility is exalted in the Resurrection! May we allow these words to touch our hearts and bring us conversion today.
