Saturday of the Third Week of Easter

*Saint Fidelis of Sigmaringen, Priest, Martyr*

Peter works miracles that bring people to faith in Jesus. The persecution and dispersion from Jerusalem brings an increase in believers. Jesus, concluding the discourse on the Eucharist, sees “many of his disciples” leave him for “their former way of life”. “Jesus then said to the Twelve, ‘Do you also want to leave?’ Simon Peter answered him, ‘Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God.’”

Saint Fidelis of Sigmaringen was a Capuchin Franciscan Friar who gave his life announcing the Gospel in Switzerland, where he was martyred on April 23, 1622.
