THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Moses reminds the people of all that the Almighty has done for them. He then says, “This is why you must know, and fix in your heart, that the Lord is God in heaven above and on earth below, and that there is no other.” We respond to the Psalm: “Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be his own.” It is a privilege to be chosen by God, to be “children of God, . . . heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if only we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him.” “Baptizing . . . in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit”, in the trinitarian formula as it is known, makes a person share in the life of the Trinity. We belong to this original “Family”, this origin of love and unity, because God revealed this truth starting with Abraham, our father in faith, and then Moses; and fulfilled this in Jesus, who has revealed it to us through the cross and resurrection. Jesus reunites us, and also those who have gone before us, including Adam and Eve, who broke this loving union through their sin. “O most Holy Trinity, Undivided Unity; Holy God, Mighty God, God Immortal, be adored!”
