Moses takes justice into his own hands and discovers that, even if he believes it was right to kill as long as it was hidden, he justifies himself. When another reveals that he knows what he has done, Moses flees out of fear. We cannot run away from God. Jesus calls all of us to ongoing repentance because we, like Moses, will continue to fall away from God. May we keep always in our minds and hearts today's Psalm response: "Our help is in the name of the Lord." Saint Henry and his wife, Saint Cunegunda, had a love for the poor. As emperor, Henry worked with the Church, seeing also the ongoing need for conversion, especially among the clergy and monks. He was instrumental in establishing "the See of Bamberg as a center for missions to the Slavs" (from the ORDO) after the Holy See approved of the work of the great missionaries to the Slavs, Saints Cyril and Methodius.
